

### Dear Church Family,

The month begins with Revival! Great times of revival have blessed our church family for many years. Extra time spent and extra prayer given have added to our church family, brought salvations and changed our worship together.

What is God about to do with us this time?





God is not resting on His throne. God has not set things in motion and then withdrawn to watch the show. God is actively working in the universe, in our world, through His church, in the lives of His people and in the affairs of nations. No element of life is beyond His reach.

Since God is always working, it makes sense to **discover where God is working and to join Him**. Often we dream up a project and ask God to bless it. But, God is already working in Carrizo Springs. Seeking His work, His purpose, and His methods enables us to jump on board. This is what Jesus taught in *John 5:19*, "So Jesus explained, "I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself. He does only what he sees the Father doing. Whatever the Father does, the Son also does."

These two truths can guide us as we conduct revival and then react to revival this month.

God has already been working as revival time approaches. God is working in Jon Harper's life. God is working in our Paul/Timothy pairs. God is working in our students. God is working in Carrizo's community leaders. The revival arrives under His direction. It is not OUR revival, it is GOD'S revival that He is sharing with us.

How can we join God in His work of revival? We can pray, praying that God will show us the people He is drawing to Himself. Pray about inviting someone, even, pray about exactly who to invite. Pray before you invite them and pray after you invite them. **What great power there is in a simple, heartfelt invitation.** 

We join God in revival by attending the meetings ourselves, singing, praying, giving and listening to hear the Lord's direction. We join God in revival by committing to obey what ever He asks of us. We join in revival by testifying about God's work to the people we work with or go to school with. We take a chance to pray with someone at work or at Walmart or HEB. We join in revival with deep confession and repentance.

"Lord Jesus, this is Your Revival, not ours. May Your Kingdom come and Your will be done in Carrizo Springs. Stretch us out of our comfort zones and let us rejoice in new souls brought from darkness to light. Redeem marriages and families and call us to Deeper Spiritual Life and to New Ministry."
